•Ensure that both internal and external customer requirements are met on time and in full •Advocate and encourage Near Miss reporting and the submission of CI cards

•Manage, set direction, and time bound objectives to the supporting Team Leaders within Manufacturing and review on a quarterly basis.

•Develop and meet training plans to upskill and strengthen you team.

•Ensure the effective utilisation of equipment and manpower to meet the required quality standards and production lead times

•To control and meet Key Performance Indicators (KPI's) for all production processes.

Proactively action with the production teams to rectify unacceptable performance •Ensure that all staff are developed and trained to carry out their duties within the Manufacturing Department.
